Eligibility

1. **Civil Servant** – as per Chapter 9 of BCSR 2010.
2. **Corporate/Private Sector Employees** – as per the “Guideline for HRD Support to Private and Corporate Sector” of the Department of Human Resources(DHR), Ministry of Labour and Human Resources(MoLHR).

Application

3. Corporate and private sector employees may submit their applications to DHR, MOLHR;
4. Civil servants may submit their applications to Agencies concerned; and
5. Agencies and DHR, MOLHR are requested to forward the applications to RCSC through online i.e, Civil Service Information System (CSIS) and hard copies respectively.

Documents Required while applying to Agency

6. Attested copy of Bachelor's (for Masters) and Master's Degree (for PhD) transcripts and certificate. Agency (civil servant) to upload the same on CSIS.
7. Candidate who are applying for PhD study are required to furnish research proposal.

Timeline

8. Application Deadline (at Agency) - **27.03.2012**
9. Application Deadline (at RCSC) - **30.03.2012.**
10. Announcement of Shortlist (RCSC Website) - **06.04.2012.**
11. Viva Voce - **18.04.2012 onwards.**

Upon selection/result declaration, candidates must:

12. Furnish Security Clearance Certificate Approval No. and date & Audit Clearance Certificate Approval No. and date to Agency (for civil servant) and RCSC (for private and corporate sector employees). **Agency (for civil servant) shall upload the same on CSIS.**

Candidate and Agency shall complete/furnish (11) **within five working days**, failing which the scholarship will be awarded to next candidate.

Kindly note that final award of scholarship is subject to securing university admission.

Selection Criteria

1. Academic (Degree) : 50%
2. Viva : 50%

Entitlement

- (i) 1st Month (with establishment allowance) : Nu.30,000/-
- (ii) Subsequent months : Nu.25,000/-
- (iii) Book Allowance (annual) : Nu.12,500/-
- (iv) Travel by flight (to and fro) during the study period
- (v) Thesis/dissertation/project : Actual on production of original receipts.

(vi) Medical claim/reimbursement : Up to Nu. 15,000/-
